CIRCULAR

Sub: Conduct of GNM Examinations by the R.G.U.H.S, for the students who come under Karnataka State Diploma in Nursing Examination Board and General Instructions to the GNM Institutions and students– Reg

- Ref: 1. Government of Karnataka order: MED 48 MMC 2023 Bengaluru, Dated 21.04.2023
2. KSDNEB/Est/21/2024-25 dated 12.06.2024

As per the ref no (1) & (2) mentioned above, RGUHS has been directed to conduct the GNM nursing examinations in its affiliated Medical & Dental colleges. The said examinations are scheduled between 30.07.2024 to 03.08.2024.

Therefore, it is informed that, the Principals of the GNM Schools will have to follow the below mentioned instructions without fail.

1. Transportation of the students to their respective centers is the responsibility of the GNM School/Colleges/Institutions or the student's own responsibility.
2. Students should have been issued a valid Identity card by the GNM School/Colleges/Institutions.
3. **Without the valid Admission ticket /Hall tickets & student Identity cards issued by the principal of the respective institutions, students will not be allowed to enter the examination halls at the examination centers.**
4. Students should come to the examination halls with their GNM school/Institution Uniform.
5. Students should be instructed about not carrying mobile, smart watch, electronic gadgets, chits, papers, books etc to the examination halls.
6. Any student who has been found copying in anyway will be debarred from the appearing to the rest of the examinations. Further such students will be informed to appear before a committee regarding further continuation of their course.
7. All the students should be seated in the examination hall at 8.15 AM i.e., forty five minutes before the beginning of the examinations in the morning session & at 1.15PM i.e., forty five minutes before the beginning of the examinations in the afternoon session of the examination.

8. Students are not allowed to go out of the examination hall, surrendering his/her answer booklets before 45 minutes from the commencement of the examination session. After 45 minutes from the commencement of the examination, if the student surrenders the answer booklets and goes out of the examination hall, such students will not be allowed to enter the examination hall again.
9. Students will be frisked by the invigilators at the examination centers for any gadgets, chits, mobile etc. Hence students should cooperate for the same.
10. Flying squads/squads will visit the examination centers to observe the process of conduction of the examination by the RGHUS. There will be zero tolerance for the malpractices at the examination centers.

Hence in this regard, your coordination is required to comply with the Government order.
