CIRCULAR

Sub: Admission to the GNM course for the academic year 2022-2023

The following are the guidelines issued to the principals of the nursing schools to follow the same during the admission of the candidates to the GNM course for the academic year 2022-2023. These guidelines should be strictly followed without any deviation or causing any inconvenience to the students.

- A. Eligibility Criteria for GNM programme: As per Circular F.No.1-6/2012–INC dated 26-04-2013 of Indian Nursing Council the eligibility criteria for 2022-2023 is detailed as follows.
 - i) The Minimum and Maximum age for admission will be 17 and 35 years. There is no age bar for ANM / LHV as on 01/09/2017.
 - ii) Minimum education:
 - a) 10+2 class passed with English and must have obtained aggregate of 40% marks. English individually from any recognized board.
 - b) 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in vocational ANM under CBSE Board recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
 - c) Registered as ANM with State Nursing Registration Council.
 - iii) Student shall be medically fit.
 - iv) Students qualified in 10+2 Arts, Commerce or Science examination or Health care Science-vocational stream ONLY conducted by National Institute of Open schooling with 40% marks.
 - v) Total marks of 5% is relaxed for S.C. / S.T. candidates for admission. Original S C Certificate should be produced.
 - vi) For Foreign nationals the entry qualification i.e., 12th standard will be obtained by Association of Indian universities, New Delhi. Institution, State Nursing Council will be responsible to ensure that the qualification and eligibility will be equivalent to what has been prescribed as above.

Student shall be admitted once in a year.

vii) As per INC the last date for admission to 2022-23 academic year is 31/10/2022

- B. The Government or any other competent authority is not responsible for any inconvenience caused to the students admitted to the unrecognized schools / Institutions for the 2021-2022 academic year. The students should not be admitted through the agents or any other sources. The institutions should issue the receipts to the students for the fees amount received from them. The students admitted by the institutions and not recognized by the KSNC will not be allowed to appear for the examination.
 - 1. The classes for the academic year 2022-2023 commences from **01-11-2022**.
 - 2. The Principal should personally verify the date of birth of the students entered in the SSLC / Xth Std. Marks card and confirm that the age of the student is not less than 17 years and not exceeded 35 years as on 31-12-2022. Irrespective of Government or Management quota admissions. In case if any under aged or over aged students are admitted, the concerned principals will be held responsible and action will be taken against them, and such students will not be allowed to appear for the examination.

- a) The students should not be admitted on the provisional or Xerox copy of the marks cards
- b) The principals of the respective Nursing Schools should thoroughly verify and confirm the genuiness of the original certificates submitted by the candidates before admission. <u>If any fake certificates are noticed by the board, the concerned principals will be held responsible.</u>

Only one list of admitted students for the academic year 2022-23 should be submitted online on or before 31/12/2022. **The payment should only be made through SBI E-pay only.** The affiliation fee payable at Rs.500/- per each students admitted during 2022-2023.

- 3. The approved list of the students along with the allotted Register Number (21DN) will be published in the website of KSDNEB for the information of the students and schools of nursing.
- 4. As per the Government order NO. Aakuka 44/MPS/2003(3) dated 03-07-2003, ten percent (10%) of the total intake capacity of the respective nursing schools should be reserved for filling up of these seats under Government quota.
- 5. If candidates allotted to the respective Nursing Schools under Government quota are not admitted within the prescribed date, the permission of the Director of Medical Education should be sought for filling up of such vacancies. Under any circumstances the vacant seats should not be filled up without the permission of the Director of the Medical Education, Bengaluru. The refusal of admission of Government quota candidates including the candidates sponsored by the Social Welfare Department is liable to cancel the entire admission list for 2022-2023 of such schools.
- 6. The schools / Institution of Nursing should compulsorily get the permission from Karnataka State Nursing Council, & Government of Karnataka to shift the school / Institute from one location to another location. After getting the permission from KSNC & Government of Karnataka, the Nursing Schools should immediately submit the permission letter to the Examination Board. Without the permission of Government of Karnataka the change of address will be treated as invalid.
- 7. a) The identification card should be issued to all the students and also to the faculty members every year for their Identification and they are directed to wear the same during the working hours of the School, Inspection etc.
 - **b)** During the examination the students and faculty members should wear Identity Cards issued by the Examination Board and also to wear the white uniform.
 - c) The students and faculty members are directed to wear white uniform only during the working hours of the school, clinical Inspection.
- 8. The Annual Vacation of 30 days may be declared in two spells. The first spell of 15 days after Annual Examination and another 15 days after the supplementary examination, 10 days Sick leave per annum may be sanctioned. Sick leave cannot be accumulated from year to year. No other holidays shall be declared other than the holidays declared by Govt. of Karnataka.

The annual vacation should not be declared at their convenience other than occasions stated above.

- 9. All the Faculty members should register their names in the KSNC Bengaluru.
- 10. The Faculty studying the MSc. course is not eligible for examination / Evaluation work.
- 11. The Names of the Faculty members with photo, Qualification, Date from which they are working in the present school of nursing etc., should be published in the website of the respective school. No faculty members changes from one Institution to another Institution in the middle of academic year i.e., from 01-09-2022 to 31-08-2023 in the interest of the educational carrier of the students.
- 12. The Faculty members of the Nursing Schools should not be allowed to leave the school till the Annual Examination results are announced as their services are required by the Board for evaluation work and other works of the Board.
- 13. The copies of the calendar of events, <u>proforma for submission of list of students admitted for the academic year</u> are available in website <u>www.ksdneb.org.</u>

NOTE:

- 1. If there is no admission of the candidates to the 1st year GNM course during academic year 2022-2023, the Principal should report the same to the KSDNEB and KSNC before 31-12-2022 positively.
- 2. The Nursing Institutions should not resort to the unethical practice of obtaining service bonds from the candidates to work as staff nurses in the affiliated hospitals and retaining of their original certificates. The instructions of Indian Nursing Council contained in Circular No. F NO.1.5/GB CIR / 2011/INC dated 29/08/2011 of the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi, should be followed strictly.
- 3. The Diploma Certificates / Marks Cards of the students issued to the schools should be handed over to the concerned students immediately without any delay and should not be retained till the students complete the course.
