CIRCULAR

Sub: Dates for applying for November-2022 Annual GNM Examination

The following instructions are issued for conducting November-2022 Annual Examination.

1. The applications should be properly scrutinized and the applications of eligible students should only be uploaded.
The applications can be uploaded from 18-10-2022 to 31-10-2022.

- **The fees paid once will not be refunded or adjusted to any other fees.**

2. The Examination fee should be paid through SBI E-payment Option Only.

- * **NEFT, RTGS, Cheques, DD's & other mode of payment will not be accepted and will be strictly rejected.**

For 1st& 2nd Year Fresh students fee structure is as follows.

First Year 05 Subjects X Rs.300 = Rs.1,500/-

Second Year 07 Subjects X Rs.300 = Rs.2,100/-

For repeaters the examination fee is Rs.300/- per Subject (Theory & Practical Separate)

3. All the Principals are informed to issue School ID Badge to all the students for their Identity and they are directed to wear the same during the examination, and also the students and faculty members should be directed to wear white uniform photos during the examination.
4. For academic clarification the Principal or Senior Nursing Tutors should only come to the Examination Board.
5. **The Internal assessment marks for each Theory paper is 25 marks. The students should score a minimum of 13 marks to pass. Similarly, the Internal Assessment marks for practical is 50 marks. The students should score a minimum of 25 marks to pass. The students those who have not scored the minimum marks in Internal Assessment is not eligible for writing the examination. Internal Assessment Score Sheets for Theory and Practical for the 1st, & 2nd students and Mental Health Nursing score sheet should be uploaded online only. Date of availability to upload will be intimated in due course.**
6. **The students should have attended 80% of Theory & Practical classes to appear for the annual Examination.**

7. **External Practical Marks should be uploaded immediately after the completion of each practical examination session wise.**
8. **The Principals are requested to furnish the Institution E-mail I.D. if not given already, and if there are any changes, fresh E-mail I.D. should be informed immediately to KSDNEB.**
